LELD Upgrading Electrical Service Along Littleton Common

LITTLETON -- Littleton Electric Light Department crews are upgrading the electrical infrastructure in the area of the Littleton Common to replace aging equipment and increase system reliability and capacity to support future growth.

The project involves replacing poles and upgrading to higher-capacity electrical lines from the Common heading east to 240 Great Road. Crews will also replace the underground electrical infrastructure throughout the Common.

With the new electrical lines in place, LELD crews will connect customers in the area to the new circuit. The improvements in the system will require scheduled outages, and LELD will contact customers to notify them in advance of the date and duration of upcoming service interruptions.

The system upgrades are ongoing and are expected to continue through the end of April.
